The Rejoice for September, October & November is on the table in the foyer along with the **Upper Room** for September & October. Please feel free to take one or both for yourself or a friend.

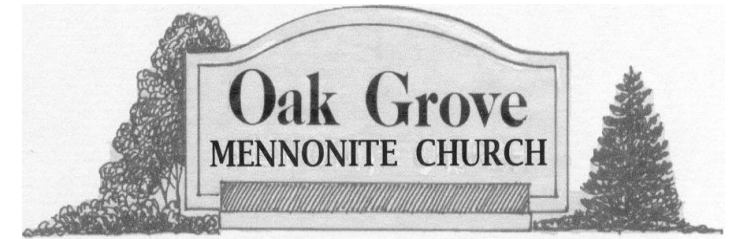
