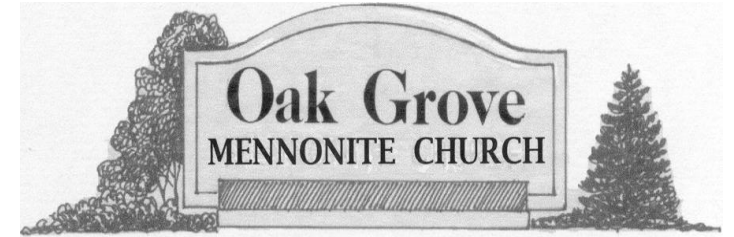

- 2.) \$3000 for Reed Hostetler to help support a six-month mission trip to Thailand to work with *Remember Nhu*. This organization helps care for children who are vulnerable to being sold into the sex trade to supplement family income. The committee will meet after church today, July 9, to finalize approval of this request.

Opportunity to host an international young adult: Mennonite Central Committee is looking for two families in the Kidron area for two young adult men from Jordan and Indonesia who will be participating in MCC’s International Volunteer Exchange Program (IVEP) beginning in August. Both will be serving at Central Christian Schools. Host families have the opportunity to learn about a new culture from the IVEP participant they host, as well as getting to understand their own culture in a new way when they see it through the eyes of someone experiencing it for the first time. Each host gets a monthly stipend that is to be used to cover some of the costs for the room and board of the IVEP participant.
