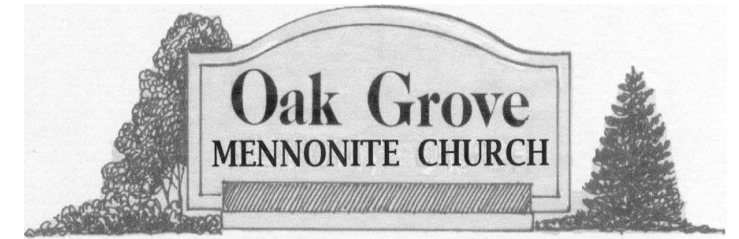
From the Property Commission: When the new front sign becomes operational, the current message sign, posts, and vinyl letters will become available on a donation basis. Please contact the church office if you are interested.
