On June 8, at 9 AM, we invite you to join other Oak Grovers at the Oak Grove church parking lot to begin the Faith Build, a Habitat house project to provide a home for the Tarpley family. We will be framing the walls for the garage of the house in our parking lot and then transporting them to the site on West Oak Street in Orrville. There will also be an opportunity for our children to get involved that morning by helping build items that will be sold at the Habitat store to raise money for the project, such as dog houses, bird houses, bird feeders and other small items.

This project was brought to the Outreach Commission a few months ago by Beth Weaver, the Executive Director of the Wayne County Habitat for Humanity. Beth gave a wonderful presentation of what this is all about when she shared her story at the April 7 Sunday morning service, which can be accessed through the Oak Grove website.

With funds we had available from the MDS project from last summer that never materialized due to a number of reasons, we were able to commit about \$5800 so far to the project. Those funds were used to purchase the materials for the garage. You do not need to bring any tools, as they will be provided, and lunch will be provided by the Fellowship and Service commission.

Later, there will also be opportunities to work on site at the house. We are partnering with other area churches and will be working together for the project. There is a display set up in the foyer and information will be posted with updates as they become available.

So let us come together under the leading of God’s Spirit to join others in creating a new home for a family in need, as we give thanks to our gracious Lord for His care of us.
