**From People to People Ministries:** We at People to People Ministries are busy preparing for our annual **Back to School Project**, which takes place this year August 5-9 at the Wooster Church of the Nazarene. It is our goal to provide children of families in need with new underwear, new socks, a voucher for new shoes, school supplies, and “nice as new” clothing. Last year, we outfitted 812 children for school!

A project this large requires hundreds of volunteers, and we’re going to need your help. Women, men, and college-age students will be given full training to assist the children one-on-one in making clothing selections. High school youth groups are needed and encouraged to help us set up, move boxes, and clean up at the end of the week.

You might also consider collecting school supplies for the project. This year we were going to try something a little different for those individuals that do not know what to collect.
